## ALLIUM GLOBEMASTER

One of the most striking alliums, Globemaster provides magnificent purple color in luxurious shades of violet. Its globes can measure up to 10" around and are comprised of hundreds of little star-shaped florets. Use these hardy gems to provide interesting, long-lasting architecture to your garden and fill the gap between spring and summer flowering plants.

## **ALLIUM MOUNT EVEREST**

Award-winning Mount Everest is a stunning beauty in the garden with 6-inch wide umbels of snow-white flowers atop sturdy, upright 2'-3' stems. Naturalizes easily and attracts butterflies. For best visual impact, plant in groups of at least 10-15 bulbs. Pair with Allium Globemaster for a festive garden experience!

## **ALLIUM SCHUBERTII**

This popular heirloom with stunning sparkler-like blooms is a definite conversation piece. It boasts huge, 12-15" loose, spidery flowers bursting from a thick, sturdy stem that looks like a botanical firework. Wonderful as a dried specimen, too. We love it so much, we made it the SHS logo!

## **ALLIUM SUMMER DRUMMER**

A towering presence in the garden! The Summer Drummer is the tallest and latest blooming of all allium. This variety uniquely consists of two colors, with 4-6" diameter globes comprising hundreds of star-shaped purple florets tipped in creamy white.

## **ANEMONE DE CAEN SYLPHIDE**

Beautiful scarlet-pink variety of the anemone de Caen family. Poppy-like flowers with powdery domes of black stamens at center. Quite prolific and can last up to four weeks. These beauties also attract butterflies!

## **CROCUS SPRING BEAUTY**

Diminutive beauty boasts a profusion of small flowers with exterior dark grape-purple flames, paler interior and grass-like foliage. Their hardiness and early flowering make them a must for the garden. Spring Beauty multiplies rapidly, creating a spring tapestry for the lawn.

## **DAFFODIL AVALANCHE**

Valued for its perfusion of blooms, Avalanche features snowy white petals with buttery yellow cups. Up to 10-15 dollish 1" flowers per tall stem make a great cut flower. Flowers give off a wonderful musky sweet fragrance.

- \*Plant 4-5 per sq. ft./6" deep

## DAFFODIL RED DEVON

**10 bulbs/\$8.00**

Bold orange ruffling cups at the center of Devon's large 4" yellow blooms are a knockout in the garden. This award-winning heirloom is lightly perfumed, making it excellent for bouquets. A dependable performer in borders or containers and even flourishes in a naturalized setting.

- \*Full sun/part shade
- \*18" high
- \*Fragrant/deer resistant
- \*Plant 7-8 per sq. ft/6" deep



## HYACINTHUS ORIENTALIS 'JAN BOS'

**3 bulbs/\$8.00**

With its slender flowering stalks and brilliant blooms of vermillion red, 'Jan Bos' has won numerous horticultural awards. Plant it where you'll be able to enjoy its heavy perfume. For best visual impact, plant in groups of at least 5 or with other flowering bulbs. Pollinators love it!

- \*8" high
- \*Highly fragrant/deer resistant
- \*Plant 4 per sq. ft/6" deep
